Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and disregards the offenses of others].

Tonight: Part 4 - Watch Your Mouth

Words are a powerful force! Words create things...

Proverbs 18:21 – AMP

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and they who indulge in it shall eat the fruit of it [for death or life].

James 3:2-12 - NLT

Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For if we could control our tongues, we would be perfect and could also control ourselves in every other way.

- (3) We can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth.
- (4) And a small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong.
- (5) In the same way, the tongue is a small thing that makes grand speeches. But a tiny spark can set a great forest on fire.
- (6) And the tongue is a flame of fire. It is a whole world of wickedness, corrupting your entire body. It can set your whole life on fire, for it is set on fire by hell itself.
- (7) People can tame all kinds of animals, birds, reptiles, and fish,
- (8) but no one can tame the tongue. It is restless and evil, full of deadly poison.
- (9) Sometimes it praises our Lord and Father, and sometimes it curses those who have been made in the image of God.
- (10) And so blessing and cursing come pouring out of the same mouth. Surely, my brothers and sisters, this is not right!
- (11) Does a spring of water bubble out with both fresh water and bitter water?
- (12) Does a fig tree produce olives, or a grapevine produce figs? No, and you can't draw fresh water from a salty spring.

Refuse Gossip

Gossip

One who chatters idly or repeats rumors about others.

Gossip spreads division and disunity.

Don't repeat scandal. Don't say about someone in their absence what you would not say in their presence.

You're just as guilty if you **listen!**

Love believes the best of every person.

Quote - *Signposts on the Road to Success*

Proverbs 6:16-19 - NLT

There are six things the Lord hates — no, seven things he detests: (17) haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent, (18) a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong, (19) a false witness who pours out lies, a person who sows discord in a family.

Message – a troublemaker in the family...

Psalm 15 - NLT

Who may worship in your sanctuary, Lord? Who may enter your presence on your holy hill?
(2) Those who lead blameless lives and do what is right, speaking the truth from sincere hearts. (3) Those who refuse to gossip or harm their neighbors or speak evil of their friends. (4) Those who despise flagrant sinners, and honor the faithful followers of the Lord, and keep their promises even when it hurts. (5) Those who lend money without charging interest, and who cannot be bribed to lie about the innocent. Such people will stand firm forever.

Satan is the author of Slander (Gossip)

Slander

The oral utterance or spreading of a falsehood, harmful to another's reputation.

Satan slandered God when he was one of God's angels...and was kicked out of heaven over it...

Ezekiel 28:16-18 - NKJV

By the abundance of your trading You became filled with violence within, And you sinned; Therefore I cast you as a profane thing Out of the mountain of God; And I destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the fiery stones. 17 Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; You corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor; I cast you to the ground, I laid you before kings, That they might gaze at you. 18 You defiled your sanctuaries By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, And I turned you to ashes upon the earth In the sight of all who saw you.

Dake's Annotated Reference Bible

Trading: Merchandising (KJV), Trafficking (KJV)

Hebrew: rekullah (H7404), traffic. It refers to Lucifer's walking up and down slandering God to his own subjects on earth, and to God's subjects among the angels, until he had all his earthly subjects rebelling against the Creator, as well as over one-third of the angels (Isaiah 14:12-14; 2 Peter 3:4-6; Rev 12:4). Whatever it was, it is clear here that the behavior resulted in violence; and Lucifer sinned and broke with God

If Satan spread gossip and slander in heaven, and was cast down from there to earth, then who do you think is behind gossip and slander today?

Example - any person used in any way to hinder the ministry of the local church is being used by Satan.

Our church covenant...

Listen to the Scriptures:

Psalm 109:2-5 - NLT

While the wicked slander me and tell lies about me. (3) They surround me with hateful words and fight against me for no reason. (4) I love them, but they try to destroy me with accusations even as I am praying for them! (5) They repay evil for good, and hatred for my love.

Psalm 50:20-21 - NLT

You sit around and slander your brother — your own mother's son. (21) While you did all this, I remained silent, and you thought I didn't care. But now I will rebuke you, listing all my charges against you.

Proverbs 11:9 - NLT

With their words, the godless destroy their friends, but knowledge will rescue the righteous.

Revelation 12:10 - NLT

Then I heard a loud voice shouting across the heavens, "It has come at last— salvation and power and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down to earth—the one who accuses them before our God day and night."

Psalm 34:13 - NLT

Then keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies!

1 Peter 3:10-12 - NLT

For the Scriptures say, "If you want to enjoy life and see many happy days, keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies. (11) Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it.(12) The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right, and his ears are open to their prayers. But the Lord turns his face against those who do evil."

Titus 3:2 - NLT

They must not slander anyone and must avoid quarreling. Instead, they should be gentle and show true humility to everyone.

1 Corinthians 4:13

We appeal gently when evil things are said about us. Yet we are treated like the world's garbage, like everybody's trash—right up to the present moment.

Psalms 101:5 - MSG

I put a gag on the gossip who bad-mouths his neighbor; I can't stand arrogance.

James 4:11 - NLT

Don't speak evil against each other, dear brothers and sisters. If you criticize and judge each other, then you are criticizing and judging God's law. But your job is to obey the law, not to judge whether it applies to you.

Action Points:

What to do if someone seeks to entice you to listen to gossip or slander:

1. Immediately stop the conversation and ask the person to pray with you, and lead in a prayer for the person they were seeking to gossip about.
2. Stop the conversation, and mention kindly that you are the wrong person to talk to about the issue with the other person. Kindly suggest that they go talk personally to the individual they were seeking to talk about.
