1 John 5:4 (NKJV)

**Five Biblical Reasons Why We Need to Exercise Faith:**

1. Satan originated in heaven and was thrown out, banished to earth (Ezekiel 28:11-19).
2. At creation, God gave mankind a time limited authority over the earth (Genesis 1:26-28).
3. When Adam sinned, authority over the earth was transferred to Satan (Luke 4:5-6).
4. Satan has a legal right to be here until man's original lease of dominion runs out (Matthew 8:29; Revelation 12:12).
5. All opposition to God's will comes from Satan's legitimate right to rule until the Second Coming of Christ (John 10:10; Ephesians 6:12).
